Question Two

a) Paul is the manager of a software development section. On Tuesday at 10.00am he and his fellow section heads have a meeting with their group manager about the staffing requirements for the coming year. Paul has already drafted a documentation "bidding" for staff. This is based on the work planned for his section for the next year. The document is discussed at the meeting. At 2.00pm Paul has a meeting with his senior staff about an important project his section is undertaking. One of the programming staff has just had an accident and will be in hospital for some time. it is decided that the project can be kept on schedule by transferring another team member from less urgent work to this project. A temporary replacement is to be brought in to do the less work but this may take a week or so to arrange. Paul has to phone both the human resource manager about getting a replacement and the end user for whom the less urgent work is being done, explaining why it likely to be delayed.
