Question Two

You are a paramedic and respond to a scene of a possible cardiac arrest. A young man lies motionless on the pavement. He is having a few agonal gasps but otherwise appears lifeless. Bystanders report that he "just collapsed". The scene appears safe. No one has started

Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). The man otherwise appears healthy and is in casual, clean attire. There are no indications of trauma. He has stopped breathing as you approach and he is cyanotic

- b. (i) List two examples of shockable cardiac rhythms (2 marks)
 - (iii) State two examples of non shockable cardiac rhythms (2 marks)
