 - (c) Having taken a group of tourists for a tour, you are requested by the tour company to submit a tour report. Describe the kind of information likely to be included in the tour report. (10 marks)

- Q.2(a) You are an airport representative of a tour company meeting arrival clients who happens not to retrieve his baggage from the carrier. Explain to the client the channels for lodging this complaint with the carrier. (10 marks)
 - (b) Many travelers use air transportation to and within destinations. Describe the procedure for planning itineraries by air. (10 marks)
- Q.3(a) Tourist transport by train is not very popular in Kenya however some tourists to use it. Highlight SIX reasons why these tourists may prefer this mode of transport while travelling in Kenya. (12 marks)
 - (b) A group of visiting travel agents want to know of Check in/out formalities within a particular accommodation establishment. Describe to them the process highlighting the important formalities.
