SECTION A (Answer ALL questions)
Q. 1 The following chart describes an itinerary for some 10 American tourists who will visit Kenya on $20^{\text {th }}$ August 2010 for a tour of one week. They arrive via Jomo Kenyatta International airport via BA4082, ETA 14.00 HRS. They are to depart 1 week later via the flight BA4083, ETD 15.30 HRS after departing Mombasa via KQ608 which arrives at Jomo Kenyatta International airport on the same day at 13.30 HRS .

(a) Construct a possible itinerary for the group for 1 week.
(13 marks)
(b) Assuming the following:

- Transportation is by use of minivans hired at a cost of US\$200 per day.
- Flight from Mombasa cost each person US\$ 100
- Accommodation at the cost of $\mathrm{FB}=\mathrm{US} \$ 350 \mathrm{PP}$
- $\mathrm{HB}=\mathrm{US} \$ 250 \mathrm{PP}$
- $\mathrm{BB}=\mathrm{US} \$ 180 \mathrm{PP}$
- Bed only = US\$ 150 PP
- Single meal = US\$ 50 PP
- Entry to any wildlife conservation area = US\$ 40 PP
- Entry to any museum or heritage site = US\$ 20 PP
- Entry to any exclusive recreational centre = US\$ 5 PP
- Any support service charge = US\$ 5 PP

Cost the itinerary for the group.
(c) Assuming that the tour company has secured contract rate with all the accommodation centres involved at 20\% discounted rate calculate its total commission.
(d) Assuming a mark up of 30\%, calculate the gross income of the tour company.
(2 marks)
(e) Assuming an operational cost of $10 \%$ of the gross income, calculate the total net income for the tour company.
(1 mark)

## SECTION B

Q. 2 (a) As a fresh graduate you are to be employed as a trainee tour operator in a tour company. Describe FIVE of your roles in the tour company.

(b) As a tourist intending to come to Kenya you are required to make reservation through a tour company for the convenience of your travel. Highlight FIVE common services that the tour company may make a reservation for on your behalf.
(10 marks)
Q. 3 (a) As an employee of a travel company your manager requests you to make a reservation for accommodation for a group of tourist by telephoning. Describe how you would undertake the task.
(b) As an airport representative welcoming inbound tourists at an international airport you are required to brief them on various issues pertaining to their stay at the destination. Explain FIVE issues on which you would brief them.

Q. 4 (a) A group of visiting travel agents want to know of Check in/out formalities within a particular accommodation establishment. Describe to them the process, highlighting the important formalities.

(b) Some Japanese tourists would like to visit northern touristic circuit in Kenya. Explain to them FIVE important places of interest that you would like them to visit.
Q. 5 (a) You are to describe to a class of tourism student the different tours that may be available to tourists to a particular tourist destination. Explain FIVE such tours.
(b) Explain FIVE advantages of tourists buying tour packages rather than buying the different elements of the tour separately.
