- b) Write a program using JAVA programming language that prompts the user to enter two integers then prints the difference, product and modulus of the two integers. (8 Marks)

Question THREE (20 Marks)

- a) Write a statement that declares an array named marks of size 5 and initialize the array elements with 5 floating point values of your choice. (4 Marks)
- b) Write a program that accepts marks in four subjects, computes the average and awards an order of merit based on the average mark using the following classification. (16 Marks)

Average mark	Order of Merit
75-100	Distinction
65-75	Credit
50-65	Pass
0-50	Fail

- a) Using an appropriate example, differentiate between Do...while and while... statement. (6 Marks)
- b) Write a program that gets the sum of all numbers between 100 and 300 that are divisible by 5 using the:
 - i. do...while loop (4 Marks)
 - ii. for loop (4 Marks)
- c) What are the similarities and differences between a class and an object? (6 Marks)
