Question ONE

- b. Explain any three specific family planning methods, giving their advantages and disadvantages. (12mks)

Question THREE

- a. Discuss the socio political approach of explaining family violence. (8mks)
- b. Studies suggest that disadvantaged groups in rural areas generally underutilize therapeutic services. Identify four such groups and give the services they need that are provided by national and county governments. (give suitable examples) (12mks)

Question FOUR

- a. Explain five primary interventions that a counselor can recommend to a manager to deal with stress (10mks)
- b. Describe the steps of crisis counselling that you would recommend for a victim of rape. (12mks)

Question FIVE

- a. Discuss the aims of couples' counseling as a primary intervention to address divorce. (10mks)
- b. By use of examples, discuss the five stages of grief that a person may go through after being diagnosed with a terminal illness as proposed by Elisabeth Kübler-Ross. (10mks)
