Project

Having studied film and video production, audio production and film video editing courses at the technical university of Mombasa, you are expected to develop a 5 to 10 minutes feature or documentary on any topical issue of your choice.

Please ensure you adhere to the following:

Present program idea, including topic, likely interviewees and timelines for your project. This should be brief, no more than 1.5 pages typed in times new roman font 12 double spaced.

After agreeing with the supervisor on your program idea, you will proceed to develop a complete proposal for your production. This should give a complete picture of what you intend to do. The proposal should be no more than 5 pages typed in times new roman font 12 double spaced.

Provide a Log sheet of your shots.

After approval of the above you will be required to provide a two column script for your production.

Finally, each candidate **MUST** provide their final project/recording of not more than 10 minutes in MP4 or MOV format enslaved on a recordable CD not on DVD.

Note: any sign of plagiarism will earn you an **E** grade.
