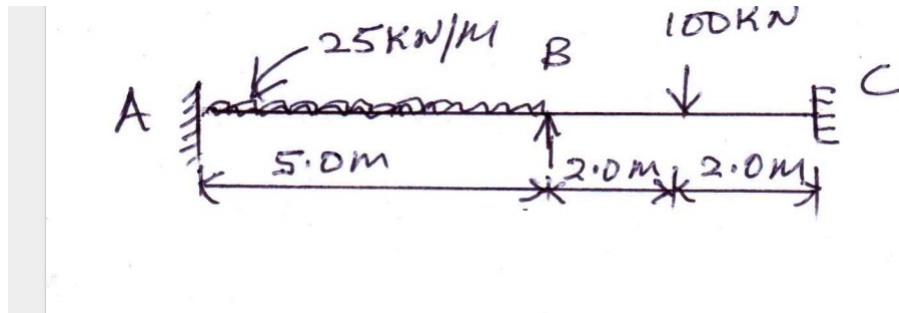

QUESTION TWO (20 Marks)

A masonry pile of 3x4 m supports a vertical load of 100 kN as shown.

- (a) Find the stresses developed at each corner of the pile. (12 Marks)
- (b) Determine the additional load to be placed at the centre of the pile so that there is no tension anywhere on the pile. (2Marks)
- (c) Determine the stresses at the corners with the additional load at the centre.

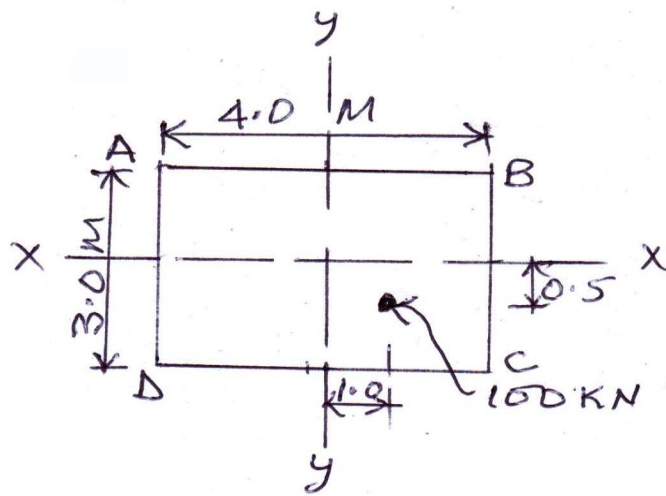

QUESTION THREE (20 Marks)

A simply supported beam has a span of 20 meters. A uniformly distributed load of 20KN/M and 5 meters long crosses the span. Determine the maximum bending moment produced at a point 8 meters from the left support. (20 Marks)

(b) Also, determine the points of contraflexure on the deflected curve. (6 Marks)

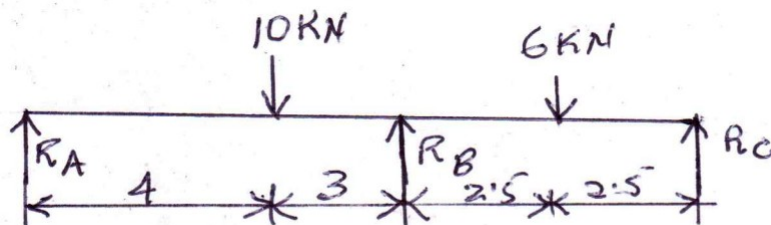

(b) Draw the shear force and bending moment diagrams. I is constant through out. (8 Marks)

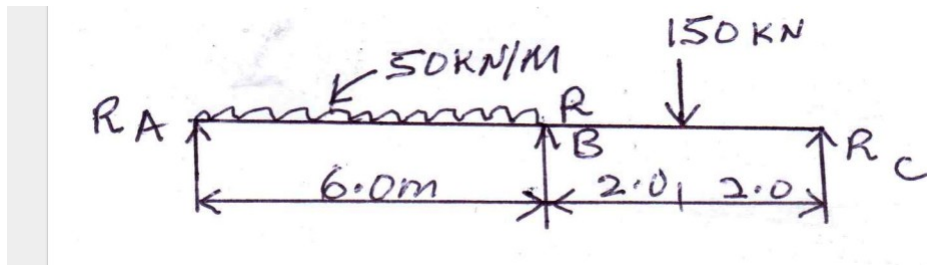
