Project Requirements:

1. Video Content:

- **Video Length:** 5-7 minutes
- **Topic Selection:** Choose a hack or trick that is practical and engaging (e.g., life hacks, crafting techniques, cooking tips, tech tricks).
- **Demonstration:** Clearly demonstrate each step of the hack/trick, ensuring viewers can easily follow along.

2. Filming Guidelines:

- **Video Quality:** Use a camera or smartphone that captures high-quality video.
- **Lighting & Sound:** Ensure good lighting and clear audio. Consider using external microphones for better sound quality.
- **Camera Angles:** Capture different angles to enhance the visual presentation. Include close-ups for detailed steps.

3. Editing Requirements:

- **Step-by-Step Format:** Structure the video to follow a clear, logical sequence. Use transitions to guide viewers through the process.
- **Subtitles:** Add clear and accurate subtitles throughout the video. Ensure they are easy to read and synchronized with the spoken content.
- **Background Music (Optional):** Consider adding background music to enhance engagement, ensuring it does not overpower the narration.
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4. Evaluation Criteria:

- **Content (30%):** Clarity of the hack/trick and ease of understanding.
- **Technical Skills (30%):** Quality of video and audio, editing smoothness, and overall production value.
- **Creativity (20%):** Use of visuals, angles, and overall presentation style.
- **Subtitles (20%):** Accuracy, readability, and timing of subtitles.

Deadline:

- All projects must be submitted by [insert due date].

Tips for Success:

- Plan your demonstration and script your narration in advance.

- Test your hack/trick to ensure it works smoothly before filming.
- Review your footage and edit to create a cohesive and engaging final product.

When handing over your project, ensure the CD contains the following structure:

i. Folder - FINAL

This folder contains the exported/completed final interview video file, properly named. Video should be in a common format (e.g., MP4).

ii. Folder - RAW FILES

This folder should contain all raw footage/files used to make the interview video.

iii. Folder - PROJECT FILE

This folder should contain the Adobe Premiere Project file for the project (interview video). It should be able to open up the project using the raw files in Folder ii above.
