- (a) Distinguish between conceptual definitions and operational definitions in a research. (4 marks)

are asked to comment on its quality. What are the main components of a good research that you will look for in this report? **(10 marks)**

- (d) Discuss problems that you may experience when using secondary sources of data. **(8 marks)**

- (a) Report writing is always a challenging job. Identify common weaknesses in research report writing. **(10 marks)**
- (b) Research reports often contain statistical material of great importance. Discuss different ways of presenting statistics in research reports. **(10 marks)**

Question THREE

Whether data are gathered in an experiment, interview, observation, or survey, the respondent has many rights to be safeguarded. Discuss some of the rights of the respondents that a researcher should respect. **(20 marks)**

- (a) What are the major sources of research problem? **(10 marks)**
- (b) Describe any **THREE** non probability sampling techniques used in research. **(10 marks)**

Question FIVE

- (a) Distinguish between response error, interviewer error and non response error in a research. **(6 marks)**
- (b) Differentiate between the following scales:
- (i) Nominal scales **(2 marks)**
 - (ii) Ordinal scales **(2 marks)**
 - (iii) Interval scales **(2 marks)**
 - (iv) Ratio scales **(2 marks)**

- (c) The internal auditor suspects that the spare parts from a small number of vendors contain errors and therefore decides to do a quality check to validate his suspicion. Discuss the advantages of using this method in a research. **(6 marks)**
