  - (v) Insect bites (10 marks)
  - (b) Identify **TEN** attributes of a professional tour guide. (10 marks)
- Q.4 You are a tour guide working for Somak Safaris and have been given the duty to brief some guests on their arrival at the Moi International Airport Mombasa. Highlight **TEN** presentation skills you could employ giving reasons. (20 marks)
- Q.5 (a) Highlight **FIVE** sources of information for itinerary planning. (5 marks)
  - (b) After making initial contact with a potential guest, one should pay special attention to several issues required in developing the itinerary. Describe **FIVE** such issues. (10 marks)
  - (c) Explain the following terms as used in accommodation facilities.

    - (ii) Single room supplement
    - (iii) Full board
    - (iv) All inclusive
