SECTION B - ART WORK ANALYLSIS				
Q.5	Analyze the given work of art by following the guidelines listed below.			
	Scrutinize the artwork and understand what the artwork is trying to say over other opinions.			
	Get a first impression. What does the artwork make you feel? Sad? Happy? Angry? Utterly confused about what the artwork is trying to say?			

Look at the colours, shades and tints. How do they affect the mood of the artwork?

Look for possible symbols, the more you analyze the artwork, the more you'll recognize and understand these symbols.

Notice the composition and perspective of the artwork. Is it cluttered? Symmetrical? What angle is it viewed?

Notice the lighting and shading. Use light for an impressive effect, light can tell the time of day the work took place. It can come from an artificial or natural source of lightning.

When you analyze the artwork, highlight the theme first and use all the knowledge of the artwork you gather to understand the theme. NB: The theme is the message of the artwork; what the artwork is saying.
